Comparatives — comparar 2 coisas

Adjetivo curto: + -er than (bigger than). Adjetivo longo: more + adjetivo + than (more expensive than).

Adjetivo	Comparativo	Exemplo
big	bigger than	A truck is bigger than a car.
easy	easier than	English is easier than Chinese.
expensive	more expensive than	A phone is more expensive than a book.

Superlatives — o 'mais' de todos

Curto: the + -est (the biggest). Longo: the most + adjetivo (the most expensive).

English	Português
the biggest	o/a maior
the most beautiful	o/a mais bonito(a)
the best (irregular)	o/a melhor

Irregulars — irregulares

good → better → the best · bad → worse → the worst.
