Modais — sentido e uso (EF09LI16)

Modal	Sentido	Exemplo
should	conselho/recomendação	You should sleep more.
must	obrigação forte	You must wear a seatbelt.
have to	obrigação (regra)	I have to study tonight.
may / might	probabilidade	It may / might rain later.

should = é uma boa ideia. must / have to = é necessário/obrigatório. may / might = talvez (possível).

Negatives

shouldn't (não deveria) · don't have to (não precisa) · mustn't (proibido).
